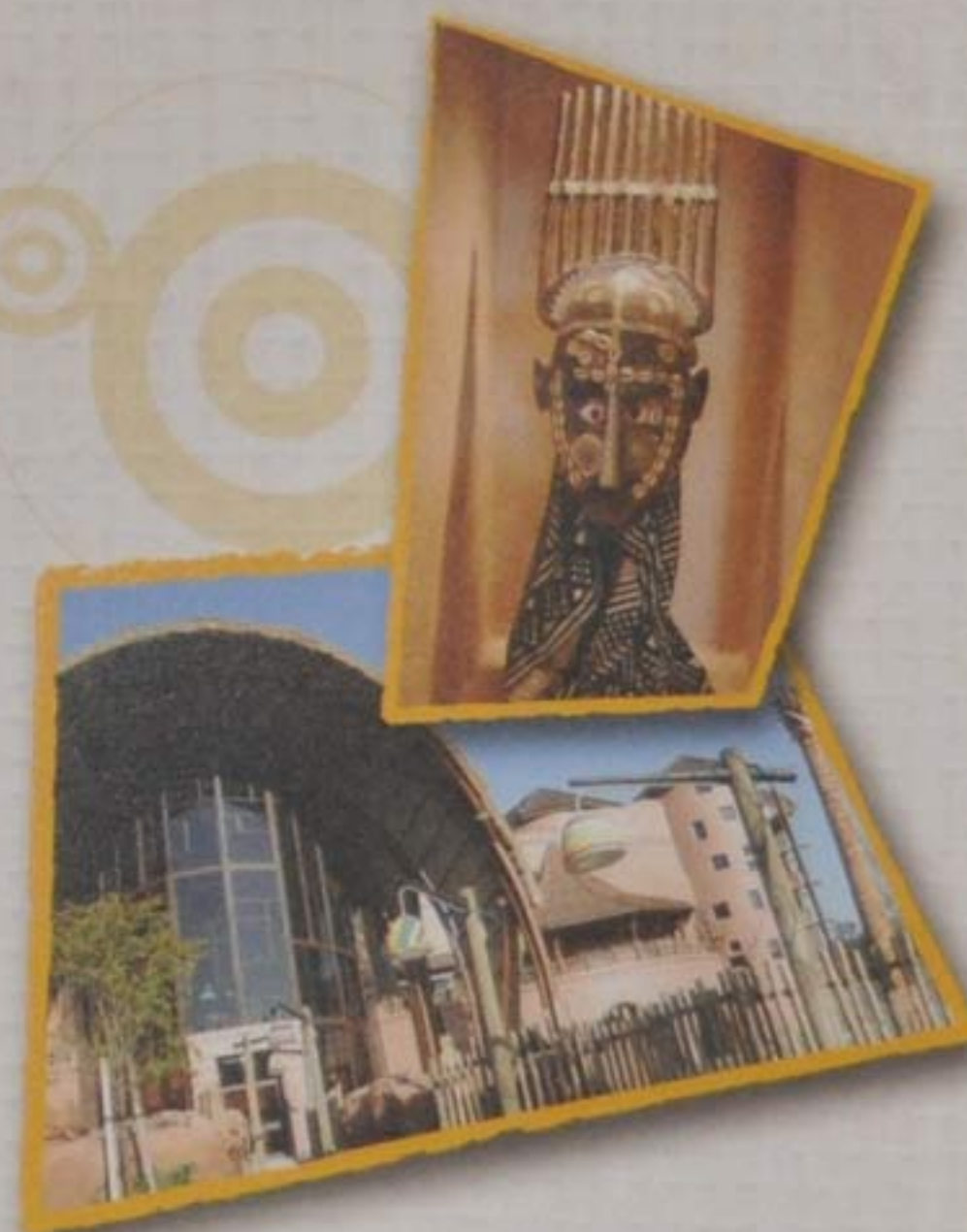

Welcome Home to Disney Vacation Club

- Disney's Animal Kingdom Villas marks the eighth Disney Vacation Club Resort.
- More than 400,000 individuals from all 50 states and approximately 100 countries are Members of Disney Vacation Club, Disney's innovative and imaginative vacation-ownership program.
- Members enjoy the flexibility to vacation at Disney destinations and other vacation hotspots all over the world, with the freedom to tailor each vacation to their family's interests and personal needs.

The Comforts of Home

- At Kidani Village, Disney Vacation Club Members and Guests can choose between four different room categories: studio (sleeps up to 4), one-bedroom villa (sleeps up to 5), two-bedroom villa (sleeps up to 9), and three-bedroom, two-story Grand Villa (sleeps up to 12).
- Studios feature one queen-size bed, one double-size sleeper sofa and a kitchenette, while villas one-bedroom and larger feature a living area, a full-size kitchen, washer and dryer, multiple bathrooms, a whirlpool tub, and more.
- All accommodations at Kidani Village feature a balcony, most with spectacular views of the resort's savannas.

- Jambo House offers the same type of accommodations with a slightly different floor plan than Kidani Village. In addition, the Grand Villas in Jambo House are one-story villas that feature their own pool table. Jambo House also offers concierge rooms and value rooms, which are not offered at Kidani Village.

Two Buildings, One Lodge: Jambo House and Kidani Village

- As you know, Kidani Village is the exciting new vacation destination you're visiting today. Phase I will open May 1, while Phase II, including the Pembe Savanna, is scheduled to open this fall.
- Jambo House is the name of the existing building, which opened as Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge in 2001 and became home to Disney Vacation Club accommodations on its top two floors in 2007.
- The name Disney's Animal Kingdom Villas refers to the Disney Vacation Club accommodations at both Jambo House and Kidani Village.
- With the addition of Kidani Village, the name Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge now refers to the entire site. Members and Guests will have access to all amenities across the resort, but must check-in at the building in which they're staying.

Kidani Village Vocabulary

- Many areas at Kidani Village have been named after various African terms that match the theme of the resort, such as:
 - Kidani Village** (ki-DAH-nee): the newest addition to the Disney Vacation Club

family. Kidani means "necklace" in Swahili, and the new resort takes the shape of a necklace with the Grand Villas forming the beads and the lobby area forming the jewel.

- Johari Treasures** (joe-HA-ree): the Resort's gift shop, located in the lobby. Johari means "jewel" in Swahili.
- Sanaa** (sa-NAH): a 150-seat restaurant and 24-seat lounge open for lunch and dinner, inspired by the culinary traditions of East Africa. Sanaa means "artwork" in Swahili.
- Samawati Springs** (sah-mah-WAH-tee): the resort's 4700-square foot, zero-depth entry pool, with a 128-foot slide and two whirlpool spas. Samawati is the Swahili word for the color "azure."
- Uwanja Camp** (oo-WAHN-jah): the unique water play area near Samawati Springs. In Swahili, Uwanja means "play area."
- Maji Pool Bar** (MAH-jee): located near Samawati Springs. Maji means "water" in Swahili.
- Pembe Savanna** (PEM-bay): Swahili for "horn," the new savanna which will debut with the planned second phase of Kidani Village this fall.

Kidani Village Themes

- The three major themes used in the design of Kidani Village are fabric, art and proverbs.
- Fabric:** The major patterns used throughout Kidani Village are from the fabrics of the kente cloths of Ghana and the kuba cloths of the Congo.

- Art:** The art featured at Kidani Village represents the cycle of African life from birth to departure.
- Proverbs:** Various proverbs are displayed throughout Kidani Village, each alongside a bronze cast butterfly.

Enjoying Both Jambo House and Kidani Village is Easy

- Kidani Village will feature its own bus stop, with service to all four Walt Disney World® Theme Parks, both Water Parks and the Downtown Disney® area, just like Jambo House.
- For Guests wishing to travel between Kidani Village and Jambo House, bus transportation options are simple:
 - To travel from Kidani Village to Jambo House, board any Theme Park bus.
 - To travel from Jambo House to Kidani Village, board any Downtown Disney area bus.

Fun Things to Look For Today

- Make sure to look for Hidden Mickeys throughout the resort, especially in Sanaa and Uwanja Camp.
- There are a total of 20 drip features or "leaks" randomly located on the holding tank of the water tower in Uwanja Camp.
- In Sanaa, the columns located throughout the restaurant represent brightly colored African beads.
